NRP Certification Completion Checklist

There are two parts to the course which you will need to complete. Part 1 includes the 2 sections of the online exam, plus the eSim and evaluation. Part 2 is registering for the "Instructor-Led Event (Hands-on Session)", successfully completing the event and evaluation. Please read the below instructions and follow in the order shown.

☐ 1: Study "Textbook of Neonatal Resuscitation" 7th Edition

☐ 2: Register for the "Instructor-Led Event (Hands-on Session)" with SMRT Indiana

- Find the course date/time that works best for you.
- Register and pay at www.smrtindiana.com/nrp-certification.
- Cost: \$150/per student.

Note: You will need to register early to ensure your seat in the class. Give yourself ample time to study and complete the online testing portion.

☐ 3: Log into AAP/NRP 7th Edition LMS and set up your HealthStream ID

1. Click on "NRP LMS Login" located to the right of the page.
2. Follow directions to "create a User ID and Password" if you do not already have an account.
3. Once logged in choose "7th Edition NRP Provider" in the course catalog.

☐ 4: Complete Part 1 in HealthStream:

Note: Exam costs \$35, which goes directly to AAP/NRP. Please plan on a minimum of 6-10 hours. It is an open book and not timed with unlimited attempts.

- Complete Provider Exam Section 1 (25 questions each).
- Complete Provider Exam Section 2 (25 questions each).
- Complete eSim portion.
- Complete the required evaluation.

Note: You must complete the "Instructor-Led Event (Hands-on Session)" within 90 days of completing the online testing of Part 1

☐ 5: Print "CME Certificate" for the course and bring to the Hands-on Session.

Note: You must bring the Certificate to participate in the Hands-on Session.

- In your HealthStream Account select "Completed" in the upper navigation. From here you can access and print your "Part 1 Certificate". You must bring with you to Hands-On Session

□ 6: Complete Part 2

Note: You must complete the "Instructor-Led Event (Hands-on Session)" within 90 days of completing the online testing of Part 1

- In your HealthStream account you will need to select the "Instructor Led Event" you will be attending with SMRT Indiana. Do this by:
 1. If not already login into your HealthStream account.
 2. Check for Part 1 Completion
 3. Next "Choose an Event"
 4. Use the filters on the left to find your corresponding "Instructor Led Event" that you registered for through SMRT Indiana.
 - a. Filter by selecting the desired date.
 - b. Filter by typing "SMRT Indiana" into the "Place" filter.
 5. Click on "Register".

□ 7: Attend your "Instructor-Led Event (Hands-on Session)"

- Check your email to ensure you have the correct time, date and location.
- You must bring your printed "Part 1 Certificate" to attend the event.

□ 8: Complete Evaluation

- After attending and successfully completing the "Instructor-Led Event (Hands-on Session)", log into HealthStream and complete the evaluation for the class.
 1. Login into your HealthStream Account
 2. Click on "To Do" in the upper navigation
 3. Choose "7th Edition NRP Provider Course Part 2"
 4. Complete "Instructor-Led Event Evaluation"

After submitting the evaluation, you'll be able to access your eCard.

□ 9: Print/Email Completion Card

- After submitting the evaluation, you'll be able to access your eCard. NRP Provider cards are now **only available as eCards**.
- To access:
 1. Log back into your HealthStream account if not already logged in.
 2. Click on "Profile" in the upper navigation. A drop down will appear where you will need to click on "Resuscitation Cards"
 - a. To Print: Select "Options" located to the right of the corresponding certification card and select "View Card" from the drop down.
 - b. To Email: Select "Options" located to the right of the corresponding certification card and select "Email Card" from the drop down and follow directions.
